OVERCOMER BIBLE STUDY

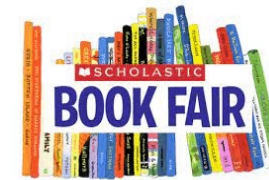

BABY BOTTLE DRIVE

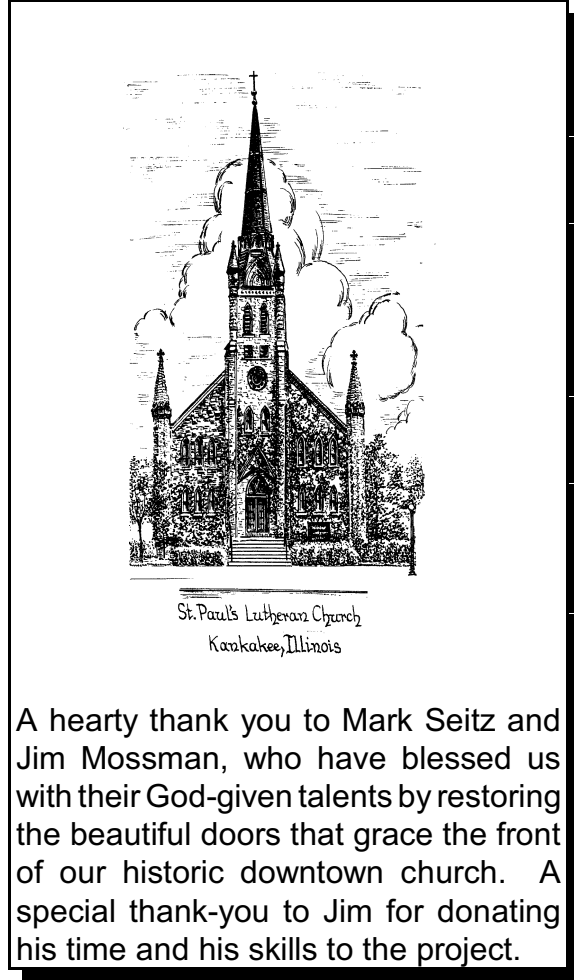
